

WHAT IS GOING ON IN FRONT OF THE CLUB?

As part of the City's yacht club promenade and marina building project, which includes the area from the public tennis courts to the boathouse 1887 restaurant some exciting new changes are in store for all of us at the Coronado Yacht Club. The city has begun work on "phase 2" of this project which includes the area in front of the club. The city has already removed the foliage and trees in front of the club, which are on the new club property obtained in the recent land swap agreement. Once the ground area is cleared 3 inch gravel will be applied to the newly acquired area and our fence will be moved out encompassing the new gravel area and expanding our parking lot. A new driveway will be provided for us approximately 1/2 way between our existing entrance and the facilities director work area. The new driveway entrance is scheduled to be operational by October 8th at which time the existing entrance from strand way will be demolished (the pavement) and removed making the new entrance the sole vehicle entrance to CYC. Our entrance will be nearly identical to our existing entrance with the same remotes and keys being used for entry and exit.
